



## 2009 League Policies

- All VRD Leagues will be administered by our professional staff.
- You **do not** have to be a Vail Golf Club pass holder to participate in our leagues.
- **Women's League** will have tee times to accommodate up to 40 players per week from 8:00 AM until 9:30 AM on Wednesday mornings (weather/frost permitting). The final 30 minutes of times, which will depend upon the number of players, will be reserved for the Women's Senior League. The Senior Division of the Women's League will be open to anyone who is aged 55 or older and chooses that division of competition.
- The **Women's Club Championship** is separate from the Women's League and is open to any women aged 16 or older. There will be a Senior Division open to anyone 55 or older.
- You must be female and 18 or older to be a member of the Women's League.
  
- **Men's League** will have tee times to accommodate up to 64 players per week from 11:30 AM until 2:00 PM. The final 40 minutes of times, which will depend upon the number of players, will be open for the Men's Senior League. The Senior Division of the Men's League will be open to anyone who is aged 55 or older and chooses that division of competition.
- You must be male and 18 or older to be a member of Men's League.
- The **Men's Club Championship** is separate from the Men's League and is open to any men aged 16 or older. There will be a Senior Division open to anyone 55 or older.
  
- ***The golf shop has the discretion to notify and move groups due to gaps on the tee sheet.***
  
- Sign-up will be taken one week prior to league play. Same day cancellation or no shows will be noted and after two, the player's privilege will change to making tee times 48 hours in advance only.
- Only league members will be allowed to play during the times set aside for league play. **Guests are allowed one opportunity to play and any additional rounds will require paid membership dues.** Guests are eligible for only gross skins and do not play in or pay for the weekly game. If a guest is invited to a team competition within the league, a current U.S.G.A. handicap must be shown. In order to play the weekly competition, there must be at least two league members in the group.

- You may make requests for pairings or allow yourself to be paired for regular events. Any events requiring pairings will be noted on the schedule. All Championship play will be paired according to handicap or results.
- You will not be required to play in the weekly game or in the skins game. You can simply play golf and view it as a social outing. ***However, if you choose to participate, you must play by USGA Rules.*** Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Any rules questions that occur during play should be handled by using Rule 3-3. Please review this rule. It is important that your intentions are stated as to which ball you will score with and that the incident is reported to the golf professional in charge following the round, even if the score was the same with both balls.
- ***All scores must be adjusted and posted by league members.***
- You may receive up to 18 strokes for net skins. No players will receive two strokes per hole in the net skins game. Players must finish the round and turn in a signed scorecard in order to be eligible for skins wins.
- Winners will be chosen by alternating low gross first, then low net. You may not cash in both categories. In the event of ties, the winner will be decided by score on back nine, score on front nine, and then hole by hole beginning on #18 and going backward.
- ***Pace of play will be strictly enforced by both the Vail Golf Club rangers and the golf professionals on staff.*** The golf professional in charge may assess penalties, as outlined in the Rules of Golf and your hard card. You will be given one warning, then on the second bad time, you will receive a one shot penalty. If a player has not made an effort to get back into position, he or she may be required to pick up the ball and move it ahead. In this case, the player will be disqualified from the daily competition, but may compete in skins on any hole other than the hole picked up. Each league member will be provided a hard card containing local rules for the 2008 season.
- Anyone playing in League must pay the membership dues. All players must pay prior to playing in an event.
- All players must have a U.S.G.A. handicap. Golf Professionals who join the league are eligible for low gross and gross skins only.
- All Men's League play will be from the black diamond tees, unless playing in the Senior Division. Seniors aged 55-67 may play from the blue square tees. Anyone aged 68 or over may play the yellow diamond tees. Handicaps will be adjusted accordingly for the Senior Division competition.
- All Women's League play will be from the green square tees.
- Please follow the Vail Golf Club dress code.
- Use of range finders is permitted.
- No shows and continual lateness will be tracked and members will lose tee time privileges and will be forced to play on a space available basis.
